The breed for March is the Irish Setter (*Erin Go Bragh*). The AKC officially recognized the Irish Setter in 1878, and it is ranked the 74th most popular breed and member of the sporting group! They are high-energy, large sized dogs but described as outgoing, sweet-natured and trainable. For having a long coat, they are surprising low maintenance with grooming. Did you know...The Irish Setter is believed to have developed from an English Setter-Spaniel-Pointer-Gordon Setter mix?
