The breed for May is the West Highland White Terrier or Westie! This medium energy and small sized dog is happy, smart, loyal and entertaining. They were recognized by the AKC in 1908, and the Westie is the 41st most popular breed of dog. The Scottish Terrier, Cairn terrier and West Highland are related, and the Westie was bred from the Cairn in white so hunters would stop shooting their dogs while hunting (knowing the white was a dog). Only pure white with no markings is acceptable for the West Highland Terrier and did you know...the all-white coat of the West Highland White Terrier should be hard to the touch; never soft and fluffy. Who knew...they look soft and fluffy!
