Breed of the Month

The breed for June is the Scottish terrier or Scottie! This medium energy and small

sized dog is independent, confident and spirited. They were recognized by the AKC in 1885, and the Scottie is the 58th most popular breed of dog. There are six acceptable colors; black, black brindle, brindle, red brindle, silver brindle and wheaten. Did you know...the Scottish Terrier was bred in Scotland as a fierce hunter of foxes and badgers?

The Scottie is also the 7th most popular breed in the White House. George W. Bush and Dwight D. Eisenhower both owned two as did FDR. While the Bush's Barney was quite popular with his own "Barney-cam", FDR's Fala reportedly received more fan mail than most presidents, and of course, is seated next to FDR in bronze at the FDR Memorial in Washington (above).
