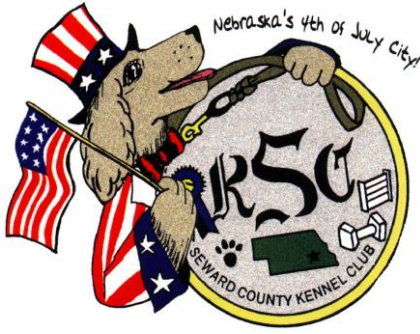

The breed for October is the Bull Terrier. This high energy and medium-sized dog was officially recognized by the AKC in 1885 and is the 57th most popular dog breed. Playful and clownish, the Bull Terrier is best described as a three-year-old child in a dog suit. Given his muscular build, the Bull Terrier can appear unapproachable, but he is an exceedingly friendly dog, with a sweet and fun-loving disposition. Did you know...their coat is short and glossy and requires very little grooming!
